# Auckland Breast Cancer Register-12 Year Data

## A special project of the Auckland Breast Cancer Study Group

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
The Register was established against a background of important advances in all areas of breast cancer. Information about current practice plays a key role in supporting the multi-disciplinary teams necessary for modern, high quality, evidenced-based care. Between 1<sup>st</sup> June 2000 and 31<sup>st</sup> May 2012, a total of 10399 patients were diagnosed with breast cancer within the Auckland region. The data for these patients, representing 10656 incidents of breast cancer (85% Invasive, n=9013 / 15% In Situ, n=1643) is presented below.


